It invites educators to explore new teaching techniques and learning technologies that can improve learning outcomes and help students reach their goals. It allows educators to customize learning experiences to their students' needs, which promotes inclusiveness and equal educational opportunity. It provides a framework of quality assurance & accountability which is essential in a country that has a large and diverse education landscape. It is the learner-centred approach that focuses on the real-world application of knowledge & skills, real-world relevance of education, and continuous improvement of the education process. It has become an increasingly important component of modern education systems, as it prepares students to succeed in a world that is constantly evolving. OBE is in line with the objectives and reforms set out in NEP-2020 and addresses the specific challenges and aspirations that our education system faces. It offers the potential to enhance the quality, employability and holistic development of learners across the country. So, it is essential to convene educators, policy makers and stakeholders for a comprehensive overview of OBE through this seminar.



# **Nrusinghanath Temple**




Nrusinghanath is a famous visiting place of the district which belongs to the Padampur Sub-division. It is only 27 kms far from Padampur. The temple of Sri Sri Nrusinghanath is situated at the bottom of the Gandhamardan Mountain which is approximately 3234 feet high. There is historical evidence that the Buddhist Shramana Nagarjuna lived here in the past. There flows a fountain near the temple which takes different names at different places in its course such as Kapil Dhar, Bhim Dhar, Chal Dhar, Sita Kund & Go Kund.

# Harishankar Temple



Sri Sri Harisankar Devasthana is a temple on the slopes of Gandhamardhan hills, Bolangir District of Odisha in India. It is 40 km away from Padampur. It is popular for its scenes of nature and connection to two Hindu lords, Vishnu and Shiva. As a holy place, along with a stream passing on the granite bed, it has given some visitors a feeling of peace. On the opposite side of the Gandhamardhan hills is the temple of Nrusinghanath. The plateau between the two temples has been found to have ancient Buddhist ruins, which are considered to be remnants of the ancient Parimalgiri University.

### **Devdarha Waterfall**



Devdarha waterfall is a popular tourist place located at the Border of Odisha and Chhattisgarh, and it is about 18km from Padampur. The waterfalls flow through large rocks that attract tourists. It is a beautiful place in the Bargarh district to visit with family and friends and weekend picnic. Winter season is a great time to visit Devdarha waterfall.
